When selecting our House Wine we looked for consistent quality, years of expertise and of course delicious flavours – which is how we decided on the distinctive Protea range by Antonij Rupert wine. The succulent range, crafted within the picturesque Franschhoek Wine Valley, include Sauvignon Blanc, Chenin Blanc, Pinot Grigio, Chardonnay, Rosé, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Shiraz.

The distinctive appearance of the Protea wine range has been designed by award-winning fashion designer, Mark Eisen, with each bottle beautifully wrapped in a bespoke floral pattern and made in the spirit of sustainability.

Each bottle is decorated with a bespoke pattern inspired by the Cape, making the bottle, like the wine an art piece in itself. The bottles have been designed with the intention of repurposing into glasses, candles, water bottles or other decorative features. The Amorim Helix corks are ergonomically thought out as twist-to-enjoy, in place of using a cork screw in order to easily be reused, and the glass bottles have been created so that the final journey of the product completes the life cycle in a sustainable and conservation conscious manner through glass recycling.

Sauvignon Blanc

Vivacious gooseberry, pineapple and passion fruit finishing with frisky dry freshness.

Chenin Blanc

Lively and fruity with a generous pineapple, guava, papaya, honey melon and citrus blossom character that is mouth-filling and dry on the fresh finish.

Pinot Grigio

Succulent peachy appeal with lemon drop vivacity and a deliciously frisky interplay of citrus and spice on the palate, with a brisk, dry finish.

Chardonnay

Unoaked, with blossoming citrus, peach and stone fruit. A dry entry has a marmalade nuance, then succulent nectarine and a lemon cream finish.

Rosé

A pretty pink blend with lively ripe cherry and strawberry along with stone fruit and an appealing flinty nuance. Light and refreshing with a dry finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon

Expressive blackcurrant intensity, as well as ripe cassis and blackberry flavours. Smooth, with a subtle oak intrigue.

Deep brambly plum and mulberry flavours etched with cracked white and black pepper with well integrated oak spice and a smooth finish.

De Wetshof Limestone Hill

An unwooded Chardonnay named after the vineyard's clay and lime rich soils that impart a text book, typical citrus fruit clarity.

Oak Valley Beneath The Clouds Chardonnay

This unwooded Chardonnay presents itself with tropical fruit aromas that reveal notes of ripe pineapple and pear on the palate.

Jordan Barrel Fermented

Flinty minerality and tangy grapefruit intensity, leavened by creamy lees undertones.

Klein Constantia Estate

A delicate combination of elegant tropical fruit with a savoury minerality showcasing the terroir. A fresh and expressive acidity with a full and lively palate.

CHENIN BLANC



Mullineux Kloof Street Chenin

Smooth, full-bodied. Mineral nose of flint and white stone fruit such as pear with a hint of honey. Brilliant straw yellow with green yellow tears. Smooth flavour with fine ripe acidity, soft mouth filling with a long flawless finish.

Cederberg

Beautiful layers of melon, grapefruit and fleshy white pear combine with a mouth coating creaminess due to five months lees contact; finishing with lively acidity.

Ken Forrester Old Vine Reserve

Melon and spicy baked apple aromas, layered with mineral notes, honeycomb and caramel from lees contact and delicate oak and vanilla flavours.

Haute Cabriere Chardonnay/Pinot Noir

This enticing blend shows elegant fruit underlined by firm acidity. Abundance of zesty fruit, white peach, lychee and red fruit, with a delectable full mouth-feel and balance.

Buitenverwachting Sauvignon Chardonnay

A deliciously, easy drinking, dry, unwooded white wine, a blend predominantly of sauvignon Blanc with Chardonnay from one of the most historic wine estates in the Constantia Wine Valley.

Hartenberg Riesling

Stony minerality, fig, and ripe pear on the nose. The palate is dry, refreshing, and crisply structured, leading to a long, precise finish.

ROSÉ WINES



De Grendel

Ample fruit reminds of red berries, strawberries and watermelon. The wine has a crisp, dry finish with a very well-structured natural acidity.

Fairview Quartz

Pale rose quartz colour in the glass. Displaying fresh quince, rose petals and pomegranate with hints of cherries on the nose and a crisp mineral finish.

RED WINES

CABERNET SAUVIGNON



Ernie Els Wines Big Easy

\$ 32

Inviting, fresh with a vibrant youthful energy of bouncy red fruit and an earthy undertow. As the wine evolves there is an attractive tension between red and black fruit with a hint of liquorice over a linear focused and dry finish.

Tokara

\$ 39

Heady aromas of dark fruits, cocoa and cedar that follow through with intense dark berry fruits with a hint of savoury; ripe tannins and well tethered oak spice.

La Motte

\$ 45

Intense blackcurrants, violets, mint and fleshy plum and finishing with seamless oak integration, texture and lingering fruit intensity.

Thelema

\$ 72

Complex and stylish, with bags of ripe blackcurrant and coffee flavours. This wine is bone dry, yet exhibits a lovely sweet fruit character on the palate.

MERLOT



De Grendel

The wine has a vibrant, dark ruby red colour. A truly splendid nose of black cherry, sweet raspberry and aromatic lavender. The palate is smooth and soft with abundant, juicy red berry fruit, sweet liquorice and exceptionally fine tannins.

Ernie Els

Rich red and black cherries, plums and a lift of mint. Succulent, a touch creamy, dark fruit unfolds laced with vanilla undertones.

Jordan Black Magic

\$ 50

Aromas of red plums and dark bitter chocolate. French oak maturation seasons the wine to accentuate the seductive flavours and generous velvety tannins.

Thelema

Bright, red fruit and hints of spice on the nose, with concentrated flavours on the palate and soft, polished tannins. Hints of dark chocolate complete this wonderfully balanced wine.

SHIRAZ



Saronsberg Provenance

A heady mix of red berry and fleshy black fruit combine with floral notes, oak spice and fynbos, with soft textured tannins.

Tokara

The nose opens with layers of high tone red fruit and cedar which lead to purple and darker fruit on a spicy backdrop. The palate is a melange of wild berries, baking spice and toasty oak with alluring freshness and drinkability. The mid-palate is juicy yet the finish is dry with beautiful plush tannins that finish long.

Cederberg

On the nose, a multiple of aromas including ripe plums and mulberries, rhubarb, Moroccan spices including cloves and nutmeg, and freshly ground black pepper. The palate is opulent with a sensual, velvety texture and silky tannins.

RED BLENDS



Beyerskloof Synergy Cape Blend

An abundance of black fruit upon entry leads to a big, juicy middle with soft, well rounded tannins. A classic Cape Blend with a pleasant lingering aftertaste.

Ken Forrester Renegade Rhone-Style Blend

\$ 43

A hint of Grenache's earthy rusticity and Shiraz's noble spice with hints of nutmeg and salty black olive on the finish. Balanced with soft integrated tannins.

Groot Constantia The Lady of Abundance Blend

\$ 45

This unique blend has a complex nose with ripe plums and black cherries on the nose, followed by a hint of dark chocolate and spice. The ripe black fruit and dark chocolate follows on the palate.

PINOTAGE/ PINOT NOIR



Spice Route Pinotage

Intense ruby red colour. Rich blackcurrant and cherries on the nose. Intense dark fruit flavours on the palate that combine well with sweet vanilla oak aromas.

Beyerskloof Reserve Pinotage

Founder and wine legend, Beyers Truter, is known as the King of Pinotage. The wine showcases dark cherries, plums and spices, with velvety tannins.

Paul Cluver Village Pinot Noir

Beautiful aromas of red fruits intermingle with roasted spices, followed by a delicious, elegant and silky palate of poached ripe plums.

Creation Pinot Noir

\$ 68

A bevy of seductive red berries, with the earthiness of shiitake mushrooms. Sheer romance in a glass.

DESSERT WINE & PORT

L'Ormarins Cape LBV

Intense deep ruby colour. Aromas of plum pudding, fruitcake, cherries and winter spices. Smooth yet rich and spicy with abundant flavours of Christmas pudding, raisins, toasted macadamias and almonds.
